- Wild Wadi Waterpark™ was created by WS Atkins, the same architect responsible for sister properties Burj Al Arab Jumeirah and Jumeirah Beach Hotel, the water park officially opened in August 1999 after three years of construction.
- Wild Wadi Waterpark™ is designed around a tale from Arabian folklore featuring Juha and his seafaring friend, Sinbad. The design and attention to detail, including characters to support the theme, led to a World Waterpark Association Industry Innovation Award for outstanding accomplishments for the design and theme.
- Perfectly designed with over 30 rides and attractions, Wild Wadi Waterpark™ offers 13 interconnected rides allowing guests to enjoy a seamless experience with more fun time.
- Throughout the park paths are resurfaced with state of the art flooring that disperses heat, allowing our guests comfortable, anti-slip and cool walkways during the hottest time of the day. Wild Wadi Waterpark™ creates unforgettable experiences in a safe and family friendly environment.
- Guests of any Jumeirah Hotels and Resorts in Dubai receive free entry to Wild Wadi Waterpark™ and guests staying at Jumeirah Beach Hotel have their own private entrance as the resort and water park are connected.
- Breaker's Bay at Wild Wadi Waterpark™ is one of the region's largest wave pool, the pool is fringed by a bank of palm trees and creates waves of up to 1.5m in four different configurations.
- Wild Wadi Waterpark™ has eight gravity-defying Master Blasters that operate on a series of high-powered water jets, taking guests on an aquatic roller coaster ride. More than any other water park in the world!
- Wild Wadi Waterpark™ is the first water park in the world to have received the Green Globe Certification.
- One of the primary techniques implemented at Wild Wadi Waterpark™ to monitor and reduce water consumption is the use of an energy/water audit. The park is one of the first to implement the Defender® filter by Neptune-Benson.
- Wild Wadi Waterpark™ is the first water park in the World to receive an ISO quality award.
- Wild Wadi Waterpark™ has six restaurants and serves 530,779 guests on average each year.
- Wild Wadi Waterpark™ has replaced 85% of its lamps with economical and environmentally friendly LED bulbs which have already resulted in significant cost and energy savings.
